Don't forget that DCAL work will be on exhibit at "The Way We See It II" in the Link Gallery in Fish Creek through August 6. The reception is Jun 20, 6:30-8:30 p. Remember, you MUST pick up your work on August 6 by 12 noon!! *The \$10/day policy applies for items not picked up on August 6.*

Our first "Kimbell's Barn" exhibition and sale will be July 5-8. Drop-off up to three pieces Saturday June 30, 10a-2p. The set up and hanging will be

Tuesday, Jul 3 10a-2p. Gallery Hosting July 5-8, 10a-5p daily. Works that are sold may be replaced with a piece of similar size. There will be 2 shifts a day and *you must volunteer* in hanging, tear down or gallery sitting in order to exhibit. If you exhibit and do not volunteer, you will be ineligible to put your work in future shows. Strike of show and work return Monday, Jul 9, 9am-12pm. Work may also be picked up on Sunday, July 8, 4-5pm.

### May Board Meeting in Brief 5/21/07

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** **Marjorie Allingham:** Multiple payments of annual dues continue; Marjorie will return the over payment with a note.

#### COMMITTEES

**Program Committee:** **Dianne Saron** reported the meetings are set for the year.

**Hospitality:** **Barbara Kenyon** has replaced Aneta Schloemer. Due to outdated job descriptions the hospitality and program chairpersons will coordinate work as needed with help from others.

**Membership:** A chairperson is needed. (**Jeanne Whildin** has subsequently volunteered to fill the position until the fall elections.)

**Publicity:** **JoAnne Rosenfeld** noted that articles have been placed in the Pulse and the Resorter Reporter. She is asking for pictures of members work, available for sale, to use with her articles.

**Website:** **Mark Allen** presented a demonstration of the excellent new website he plans to have operational at the first of the year. In the future, members wishing to establish a website link will be charged a one time setup fee and an annual maintenance fee. Mark will be demonstrating the new website and its advantages at the [June] meeting. Fee rates will be available at that time.

#### EXHIBITIONS

26 artists brought in work for the "Sprummer Exhibit" at **Dal Santos**. To increase our visibility Mike suggested an advertising flier in B&B's etc. around Sturgeon Bay. Other suggestions were: make our sign in his window more prominent, split the Spummer show into 2 shows spring and summer, provide Dal Santos more visibility in our new brochure and in the Hardy brochure and place a sign in the bathroom reminding patrons that the art is for sale. A \$25 gift certificate to Dal Santos will be the "Peoples Choice Award" at the June 2nd opening reception.

**Kimbell's Barn:** Portable and light weight display units will be constructed next month. Unit size and construction possibilities were discussed. Suggested plans should be brought to the May meeting. The exhibiting of 3 dimensional work presents new challenges as the League moves to a more inclusive membership. A co-op system will

be set up in which all participants must work a designated amount of time during exhibition hours with a board member on site. A sign up sheet will be passed at the May meeting.

**Link Gallery:** Patti Podgers will accept work June 11-13 from 9am to 4pm. Work will be hung on June 14th with the opening reception on June 20th from 6 to 8pm. The exhibit will run until July 31st.

**Liberty Grove:** **Jane Delcarson** has two openings remaining for the Liberty Grove Historical Society Art and Craft Fair. A cash box is needed and **Jeanne Whildin** will look into a solar powered calculator. **Marjorie** and **Ed Allingham** are donating 2 six-foot folding tables for league exhibition use.

#### OLD BUSINESS

Some summer/winter resident members feel they are not receiving the information on upcoming exhibits in a timely manner. Member usage of the website will help. Including a 2 month calendar with the newsletter will supplement the calendar listings on the back page of the newsletter.

**Sally Everhardus** has completed a member database. This will be a much more efficient means of managing information. She will e-mail the database to all board members so they can use the information to draw new people to committee work.

**Barbara Kenyon** is preparing the new brochure and needs pictures of members' artwork. It was suggested that she check with a couple other sources for printing costs. Paying the "paper boy" to distribute the brochure was suggested to place the brochure in the appropriate sites.

#### NEW BUSINESS

**Sally Everhardus** will work on developing a standard format for exhibit prospectuses.

**Glenn Gerber** made a motion, 2nd by **Dianne Saron** to give **Jeanne Whildin** a \$100 stipend for the coffee and treats she has provided during the past 5 years.

The possibility of placing the league's historical information on CD's for archival purposes was suggested. The accumulated paper volume has become unmanageable and is spread over many sites. Volunteers are needed to help sort and organize.

**Pat Ullom** has offered to co-chair the kite exhibit in February and is looking for a co-chair. (**Marty Gerber** has subsequently filled that slot.)

The next board meeting will be June 18, 2007.
