ARTISTS PICK-UP & ART REQUIREMENTS

All work must be picked up no later than January 29, 2012. Work remaining after this date will be subject to a daily storage fee of \$3.00 per day. This is necessary to assure proper storage, handling and insurance. The museum's staff exercise every precaution in the handling, exhibition and storage of all artwork.

All work must be ready to install. Work with wet paint will automatically be rejected. Paintings should have proper hanging hardware and wire. Wall-mounted ceramics, glass and other three-dimensional works should have proper hanging devices to support the weight of the piece. The museum is not responsible for pieces that are damaged due to improper hanging hardware or poor craftsmanship.

Three-dimensional work must fit through a standard-size doorway, and must be light enough for two people to lift. **Two-dimensional work must not exceed 30" in any direction (frame included).**

All artwork will be insured while on premises. In the event of a claim, the full value of the work in question will be established by insurance industry standards of fair market value.

All submitted work must remain in the exhibition for the duration of the show. No replacements or substitutions will be permitted.

The Museum of Wisconsin Art reserves the right to reject any work of art from public exhibition.

PURCHASED ARTWORK & PICK UP

Purchased artwork can be picked up on the last day of the show or after the exhibition closes. Artists unable to pick up their own work should provide written permission for the person picking up their work. Artwork will not be released without a copy of the delivery receipt, with the artist's signature, or a note of authorization signed by the artist.
